- Current soldier or veteran who served in the 3rd Battalion 187th Infantry Regiment.
- Applicants sponsor shall be a Life Member in good standing with the Rakkasan Association.

APPLICATION

- Applicant must complete the Hamburger Hill Chapter Scholarship Application form and provide all required documentation.
- Applicants may only receive this award one time.
- Applicants must submit a suitable photo for publication in the Shimbun.
